BYLAW NO. 1219-10**

A BYLAW OF SMOKY LAKE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of Smoky Lake County deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel and thereafter disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

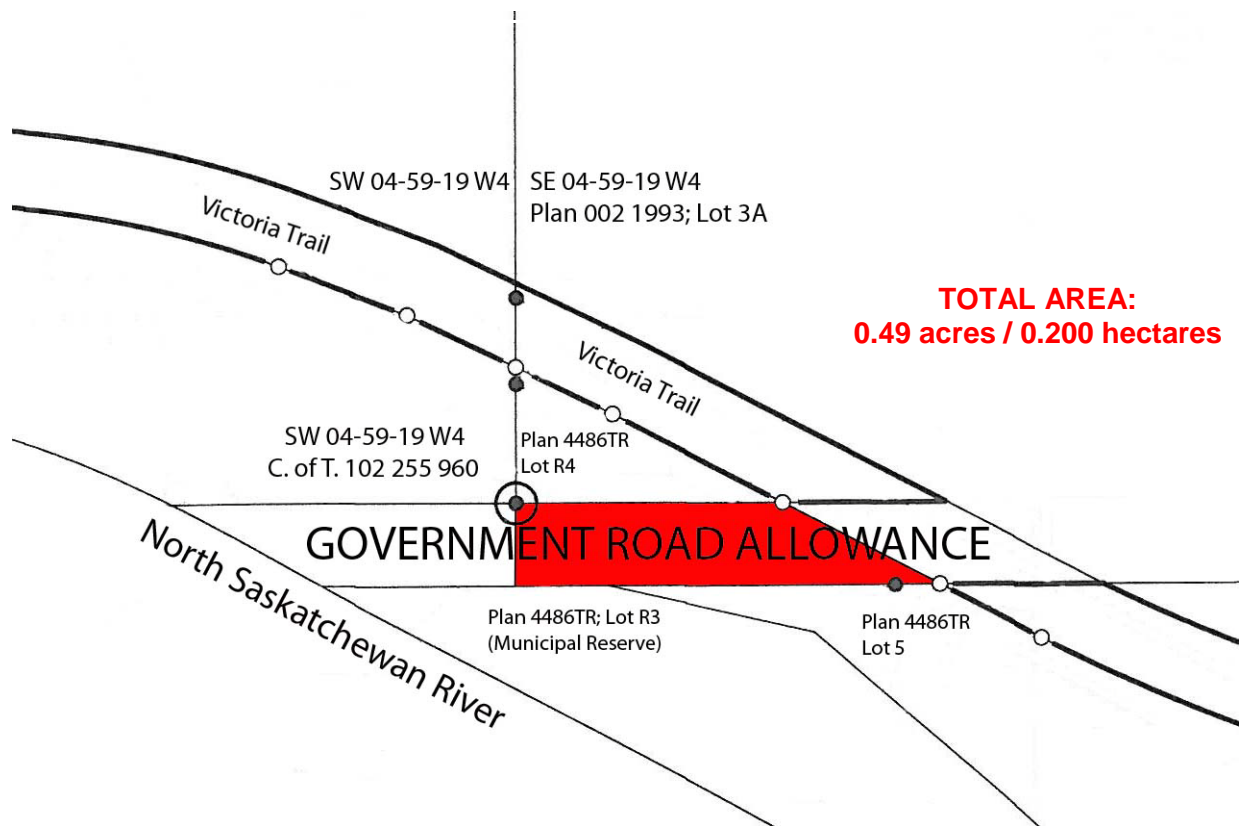
WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Smoky Lake County in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel, dispose and be consolidated within Plan 002 1993; Lot 3A, within SE 04-59-19 W4 of the following described road, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

MERIDIAN 4 RANGE 19 TOWNSHIP 59

ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE ADJOINING THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF THE SE ¼ 04-59-19 W4 LYING WEST OF THE PRODUCTION ACROSS SAID ROAD ALLOWANCE OF THE SOUTH WEST LIMIT OF ROAD PLAN 112

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS.
